

Application Checklist

Admission is competitive and based on a holistic review of your application materials: essay responses, resume, cumulative overall undergraduate GPA and prerequisite GPA at the time of application. Applicants are encouraged to write **thoughtful and articulate essay responses**. We highly recommend that students seek opportunities to work, volunteer or shadow in the nursing field. Leadership experience are also highly encouraged.
