Applicants are encouraged to write **thoughtful and articulate essay responses**. We highly recommend that students seek opportunities to work, volunteer or shadow in the nursing field. Leadership experience are also highly encouraged.

- Minimum 3.0 overall/cumulative GPA or higher (at the time of application)
- Minimum 3.0 prerequisite GPA or higher (at the time of application)
- All **12** prerequisite **completed** (grade of C or better) or **in progress by the application deadline**

- Minimum 3.0 prerequisite GPA or higher (at the time of application)
- At least **4 of the 9** prerequisites **completed** (grade of C or better) by the application deadline
